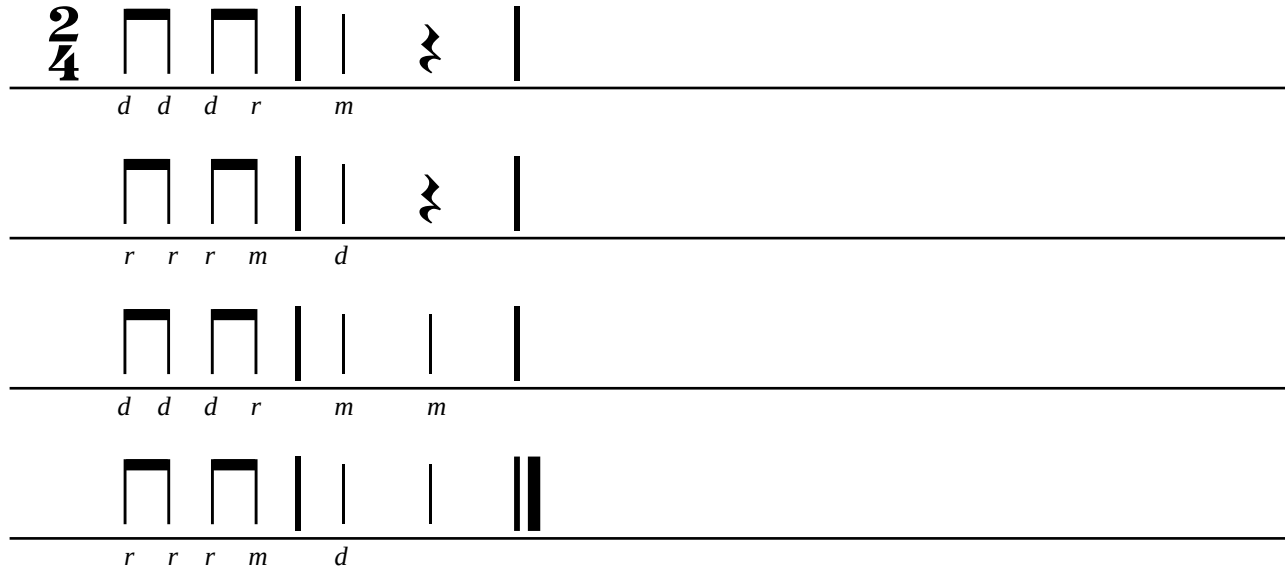

U4. Game/Dance/Movement Instructions

Formation: Children standing in a circle, holding hands. During the song, walk to the right. You may repeat the song, and walk to the left. At the end of the song, the leader calls out a number, such as "Three!" All students must form groups of three. Those students who do not find a group are "out".
